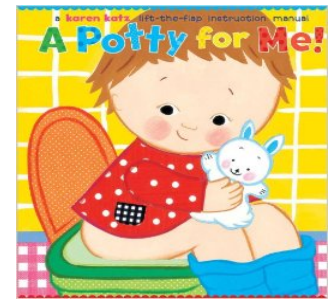




A Potty for Me!

This cute story is about a little one who receives a gift from mommy, it's a potty! Now it's time to figure out how and when to use it.

Before:

Introduce the story by telling the children a little bit about the book. Take a couple of minutes to focus on the cover and create questions. A good example question to help gain the children's interest would be, "I wonder what this story is going to be about? Do you think this child is just learning how to use the potty?"

During:

While you are reading look at the illustrations and continue to ask more questions. Talk about the process this child goes through to learn that they are finally ready to use the potty. Point out any rare words and define them in a way the children will understand best.

Rare Words in *A Potty for Me!*

Flush: cleanse (something, especially a toilet) by causing large quantities of water to pass through it.

Proud: feeling deep pleasure or satisfaction as a result of one's own achievements, qualities, or possessions or those of someone with whom one is closely associated.

Diaper: a piece of absorbent material wrapped around a baby's bottom and between its legs to absorb and retain urine and feces.

Snuggle: settle or move into a warm, comfortable position

After:

Discuss the story. Ask Questions...

- Who gave this child a new potty?
- Why did the little one wear a diaper to bed?
- What happened when this little one was playing outside? Was the mommy upset?
- What helped this little one to use the potty for the first time?

Let's Talk About *A Potty for Me!*

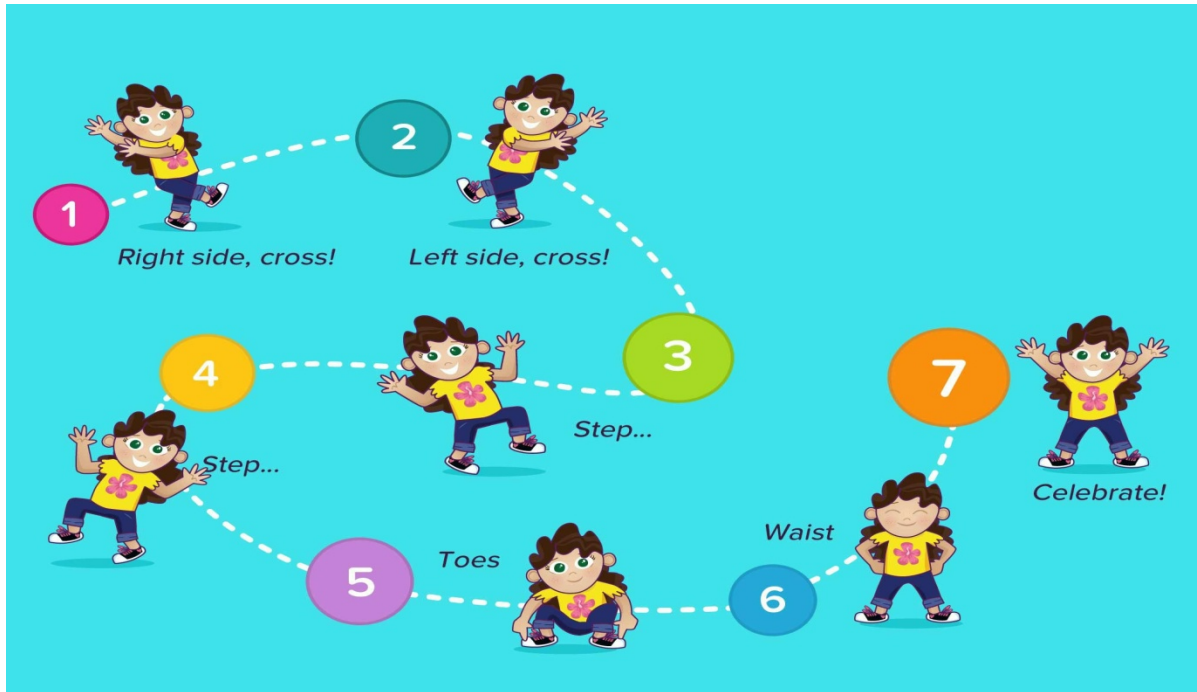
